Registration and Payment

- Cost: \$160 per session.
- Session: Mon/Tues/Weds, 8:30-12:30
- Dates available: Session 1: June 4-6
Session 2: June 11-13
Session 3: June 18-20
Session 4: June 25-27
- Registration: Forms available at Boz's Place on the LHS main floor, and on the LHS website under Humane Ed.
- Payment: Required in full to save your camper's spot. Pay via check or credit card when you turn in the registration and health form, or submit online.
- Cancellation: Must be made via email or phone one week before the first day of camp in order to receive a refund. After this date there will be no refunds.
- No adult supervision available outside of camp hours.
- No food or snacks provided. Campers may bring a peanut-free snack from home and a water bottle.
