<b>Who can Volunteer</b>	<p>Adult volunteers must be 18+ and out of high school</p> <p>*Court-mandated community service <b>cannot</b> be fulfilled through our volunteer department. Please contact our Animal Welfare Department at 303-772-1232 ext. 221</p>
<b>Average Start Time</b>	<p><b>We are very excited to have you join our team!</b> The average length of time between attending a virtual orientation and your first volunteer shift can vary between a couple days to a couple months. The time frame varies on our training schedules &amp; your availability, please be patient with us.</p>
<b>Commitment</b>	<p>Though many volunteers stay with us for years, we ask that volunteers commit to a minimum of 3 months of service of one shift a week.</p>
<b>Children Volunteers</b>	<p>8-12 year olds can volunteer with a parent or legal guardian. We ask that no more than 2 children accompany an adult at one time.</p> <p>*13-17 year olds can volunteer independently through our teen volunteer program, please see the Teen Volunteer page for more information.</p>
