

TEEN ORIENTATION INFORMATION

Our next Teen Orientation and trainings will take place on August 22 from 1-2:30 p.m. **A teen must attend this Orientation with a parent or legal guardian.** An RSVP is required to attend Orientation as spaces are limited. You may do this by emailing volunteers@longmonthumane.org or call 303-772-1232 x 278 and leaving your name. Orientation will be held in the Sally Port, the large garage on the north side of the building.

Please check the **Training Schedule** and make certain you are able to attend all training sessions for your desired area. Training is an essential step to volunteering with us as it prepares the volunteers to be safe and independent while here. Due to limited resources, there are no make-up training dates. The entire class time of all sessions must be attended to participate in the volunteer session.

We kindly ask for a \$25 contribution at Orientation for a volunteer t-shirt and to help defray the cost of administering the volunteer program. This leaves more resources available for the care of the animals. T-shirts will be distributed at the trainings.

YOUR COMMITMENT: Though many volunteers stay with us for years, we ask that teen volunteers commit to a minimum of three months of service of one shift (the same day) per week.
