



ADULT VOLUNTEER PROGRAMS



Adult volunteers must be 18+ and out of high school. Check out our amazing volunteer opportunities.

DOG TLC VOLUNTEERS: Take adoptable dogs on their morning, midday or late afternoon walks. Training consists of one 3.5 hour class.

***CLOSED FELINE FRIENDS VOLUNTEERS:** Visit and socialize adoptable cats. Training consists of a two-hour class.

TIME COMMITMENT for Cats and Dogs: Time commitment is a two hour shift, once a week, for three months. Shift times start at 8 a.m. and run until 6 p.m. daily.

***CLOSED SMALL PAWS:** Visit with small mammals: rats, rabbits, guinea pigs. Time commitment is a 1.5 hour shift, once a week, for three months. Start times begin at 11:30 each day and run until 5:30 p.m.

For following areas: Time commitment is a minimum of one shift per week for 3 months. Times vary depending on area.

KENNEL SUPPORT: Assist either in Cat or Dog areas with morning cleaning. Cat area would also include feeding and watering. Shift times are 8-10 a.m. or 10 a.m.-12 p.m. daily.

SHELTER TLC: Assist with laundry, dishes, donation area, kennel enrichment.

CLINIC SUPPORT: Assist behind the scenes with healthcare of shelter animals.

CLIENT CARE TEAM: Assist Adoption or Intake desk with data entry, filing, and general administrative support. Computer skills appreciated.

FACILITIES MAINTENANCE: Assist with cleaning and general maintenance tasks.

OTHER AREAS:

FOSTER CARE: In-home care for animals that need medical or behavioral observation or for puppies or kittens still nursing.

SPECIAL EVENTS: Assist in special events and fund raisers.
