Position Summary

The Animal Care Team Member is responsible for daily shelter cleaning and providing hands-on care for all shelter animals, assisting with adopter meets, and other duties as assigned. This position reports to the Animal Welfare Team Supervisors.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Is a representative of Longmont Humane Society, presenting a positive, friendly, and welcoming environment to all visitors.
- Performs thorough cleaning and disinfecting of multiple animal kennels, daily.
- Performs care of variety of domestic animals including dogs, cats, birds, rabbits, and other small mammals.
 - Such care includes daily kennel cleaning, feeding, vaccinating, exercising
- Maintains general building cleanliness inside and out.
- Interacts with LHS clients in a friendly and knowledgeable manner to introduce adoptable animals and supervise other meets, as needed, and ensures that quality customer service is provided.
- Promotes adoptions through visitor education.
- Good attendance is required.
